

UNOFFICIAL MINUTES OF THE JEFFERSON COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

The Jefferson County Board of Commissioners convened in regular session on Monday July 14th at 1:00 p.m. Present were Commissioners, Lynn Luck, Wayne Ledbetter, Josh Ney, County Counselor and County Clerk, Linda M Buttron. Richard Malm was absent attending the National Association of Counties annual conference.

Vouchers were reviewed by the Commissioners and the Counselor. Lynn moved that the minutes of July 7th be approved as presented. Wayne seconded. All voted in favor of the motion.

Sam Henderson, Planning & Zoning Director met with the Board. In the near future, Sam will be bringing names to the Board for consideration of appointment to the Planning Commission, (replacing a Board member who does not wish to serve another term.) Sam reported on a follow up visit to General Leasing and Marketing yard north of Oskaloosa.

Bill Noll, Public Works Administrator met with the Board. He reported that work on the Lecompton road has been pushed to the 21st of July. Work on the bridge just north of Perry on Ferguson road remains on schedule for this winter. Other projects were discussed. Bill discussed adopting a weight limit on County roads for non-agricultural traffic. He gave a resolution to Josh for legal review. Air conditioning issues in the courthouse were discussed. The Board asked that they go ahead with putting a "mini-split" air unit in the Treasurer and Register of Deeds offices as they have agreed to use their reserve funds to pay for the cost.

There being no further business to come before the Board they adjourned to meet in regular session on July 21, 2014.
