

RESOLUTION 2018-13

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Jefferson County, Kansas met in regular session on the 4<sup>th</sup> day of June 2018.

WHEREAS, it has been determined a resolution to establish a 30 MPH speed limit for a time period from 4 June 2018 through completion of KDOT Project #44 C-4858-01, otherwise known as the Wellman Road High Risk Rural Roads Project between 21<sup>st</sup> and 27<sup>th</sup> Street, on the following sections of road in Jefferson County.

- Washington Road from 1<sup>st</sup> Street North to Stairstep Road.
- Stairstep Road from Washington Road Northeasterly to Union Road.
- Union Road from Stairstep Road North to 35<sup>th</sup> Street.
- 35<sup>th</sup> Street from Union Road East to Wellman Road.
- 27<sup>th</sup> Street from Wellman Road West to Republic Road.
- Republic Road from 27<sup>th</sup> Street South to 13<sup>th</sup> Street.
- 13<sup>th</sup> Street from Republic Road East to Wellman Road.


WHEREAS, Kansas Statutes require that regulatory signs be posted by authorized jurisdictional authority.
