

RESOLUTION 2004-34

A RESOLUTION TRANSFERRING FUNDS FROM EQUIPMENT RESERVE-COUNTY ATTORNEY TO GENERAL FUND- COUNTY ATTORNEY BUDGET TO FUND 2004 EXPENDITURES.

WHEREAS, K.S.A. 19-119 allows the establishment of an equipment reserve fund, and


WHEREAS, such fund was established in Jefferson County as per Resolution 92-9, and

WHEREAS, Resolution 92-9 states that "if the Board of County Commissioners determines that money which has been credited to such fund or any part thereof is not needed for the purpose for which so budgeted or transferred, the Board may transfer, by adoption of a resolution, such amount not needed to the fund from which it came and such retransfer and expenditure thereof shall be subject to the budget requirement provisions of K.S.A. 79-2925-79-2937, inclusive, and amendments thereto." , and


WHEREAS, the County Attorney's office has expended \$9,196 more than was allowed in the 2004 budget,

NOW BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED THAT, according to the provision outlined in Resolution 1992-9, \$4,665.02 (remaining balance in Equipment Reserve-Attorney) be transferred from Equipment Reserve-County Attorney to General Fund County Attorney budget for 2004.


