subject to the following conditions and restrictions:

1. The Company shall provide the County with a contingency bond providing for and securing to the governing body performance and/or maintenance of said construction and/or facilities. The amount of the bond shall be set by the County Engineer/Director.
2. The Company will relocate and/or adjust said facilities at the County's request at no cost to the County when necessitated by improvement when said facilities are located within the County road right-of-way.
3. The Company will bear all costs to repair said facilities of the Company when damaged by the County, during construction and/or regular maintenance of the County's facilities, if a locate has not been completed within 48 hours.
4. The Company shall repair or cause to be repaired any damage to the right-of-way caused by the Company. Said repairs shall restore the right-of-way to its original condition and approved by the County.
5. The Company shall maintain its facilities in a manner which will not cause damage to any County structures or facilities and will not endanger vehicular traffic.
6. The Company shall ONLY bore under County road surfaces and NOT open cut any County Roads without prior approval from the Board of County Commissioners. If an open cut in a rocky situation is granted by the Commissioners, the Company will be required to backfill with flowable fill material up to 6" below the surface and replace the surface material with AB-3 rock.
7. The Company shall provide the County with "As-Built" plans within 180 days of completion of construction.

8. Blacktop County roads shall be bored and encased, unless specifically directed otherwise in writing by the County.
9. ALL boring shall be a minimum of three (3) feet below the surface.
10. The Company shall remedy all just claims for damages by reason of destruction of drive-ways, shrubbery or any damage, which may be caused by the Company's construction and/or maintenance.
11. Penalty for failure to obtain a Permit, as required, prior to construction will result in a fine of \$500.00. A copy of this permit must be on the job site and available for inspection by the County.
12. Notification must be given to the Jefferson County Road Engineer/Director before starting and upon completion of the work.
13. If the request is more than ¼ mile in length, approval must be obtained not only by the County Engineer/Director, it must also be obtained by the Board of County Commissioners.
14. The above requirements, 1 thru 13 are to be made a part of the plans and specification of the project.

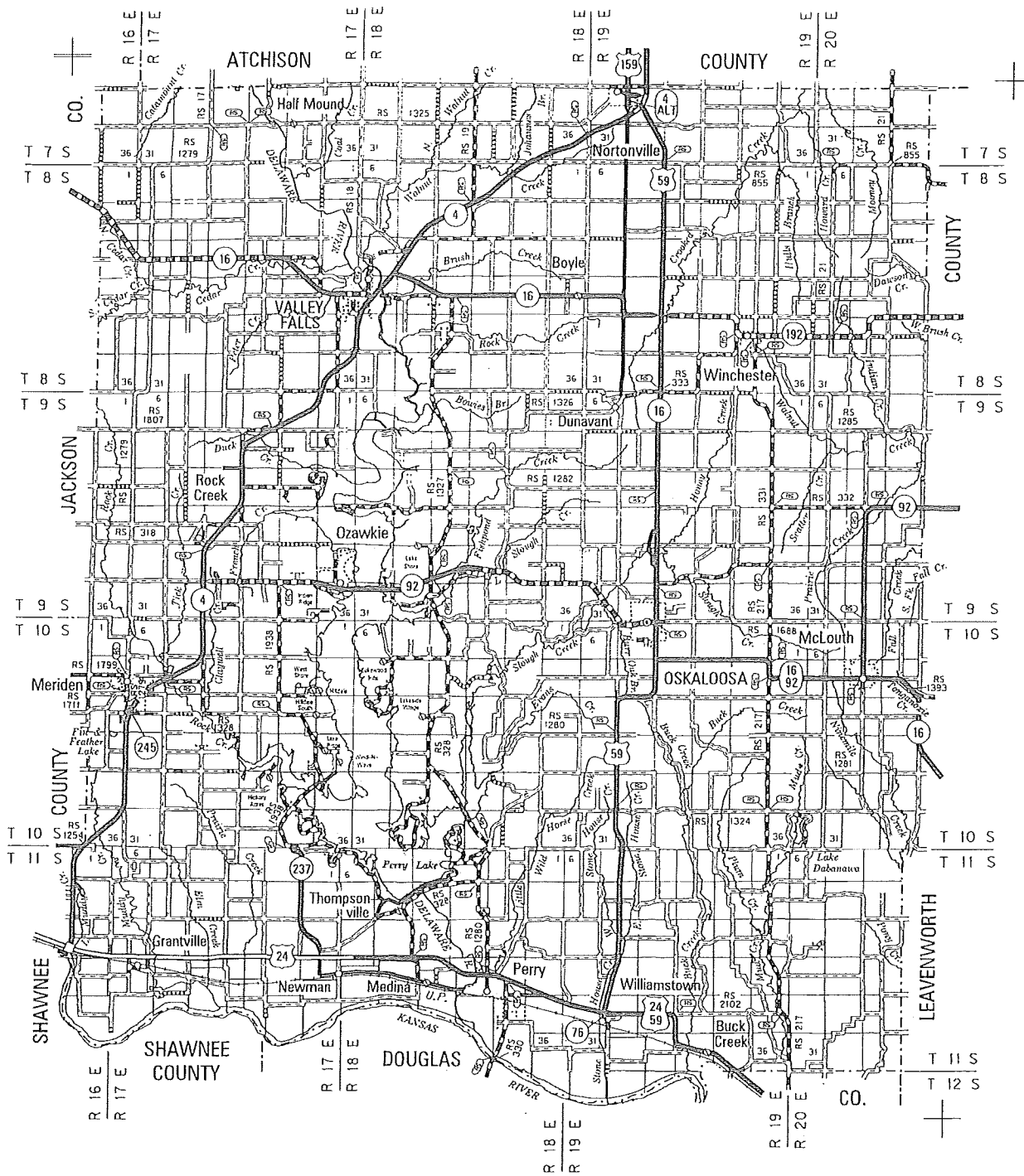

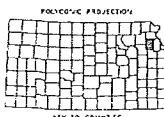
